BOS chairman DR. N. VISWANATHAN, HOD/EE, welcomed the members of the Board of Studies for the seventh meeting held on 23.02.2019.

Reviewed and confirmed the minutes of the sixth Board of Studies meeting conducted on 17-02-18

Discussed and approved the Syllabi of UG programmes from fifth to eighth Semesters of Regulations - R-2017. Further discussed and approved the Curriculum of UG and PG programmes and Syllabi for first to fourth Semester of Regulations R-2019, keeping in view of the AICTE model Curriculum and Syllabi, interest of the stake holders, college vision and mission and national requirement.

It was discussed and approved the open elective courses to be offered to UG programmes under Regulations R-2017.

It was discussed and approved the contents of the course "Embedded System" under Regulations R-2017 according to the needs of product design and industrial requirement.

It was recommended to include basic experiments like Sampling and re construction in the course "Digital Signal processing laboratory" of Regulations R-2017.

In the course, Network theory of Regulations R-2017 a separable unit for Network Synthesis was introduced.

Devices characteristics like vs characteristics of diode, BJT and MOSFET were included in the laboratory course "Analog Devices and Circuits laboratory" under Regulations R-2019.

It was discussed and approved to shift the theory course "Analog Circuits" from third to second semester and the course "Biology for Engineers" has been shifted from sixth to fifth semester in the UG curriculum of Regulations R-2019 compared with AICTE model curriculum.

It was recommended to split the course "Analog and Digital Communication" in two courses namely "Analog Communication" and "Digital Communication" of Regulations R-2019 compared to AICTE model curriculum.

It was recommended to have mini project component in a laboratory course of each semester from third semester onwards under Regulations R-2019.


Discussed on the academic performance, Co-curricular and extracurricular activities of the students during the academic year 2017-2018 and the members expressed their satisfactions.

Discussed and approved the panel of members to be appointed as examiners for various examination activities.


The above discussed matters were recommended to the academic council for further approval.

The meeting was concluded with closing remarks of the university nominee.


